Season-transcending activities: expanding the offer beyond traditional winter sports to make Seefeld a yearround attractive destination.




The seasons of Seefeld

By car: by car, Seefeld is easy to reach via a well-maintained network of roads winding through the spectacular Tyrolean landscape. Driving to Seefeld offers not only flexibility and freedom, but also the opportunity to stop along the way and explore the surroundings. Seefeld can be reached via the A12 motorway from Innsbruck and the German A95 motorway from Munich.

By train: rail travellers can enjoy a network of efficient rail connections linking Seefeld to major Austrian and European cities. The train journey itself is a

prelude to your stay, with breathtaking views of alpine landscapes gliding past your window. Seefeld has its own train station, which is within walking distance of the resort.

High-speed train stop: with the introduction of high-speed train connections, Seefeld is now faster and easier to reach than ever before. The high-speed train is your direct line to Tyrolean charm, connecting Seefeld to major cities like Vienna, Munich and Zurich.


